<u>Bulletin No. 20-27: 60-Day Grace Period for Health Insurance Policies and Contracts Not Addressed by</u> Bulletins Nos. 20-11, 20-12, 20-13, and 10-'4 Due to the Disruption Caused by COVID-19

Issued to all companies authorized to sell accident and health insurance in New Jersey pursuant to Titles 17 or 17B of the New Jersey Statutes

<u>Bulletin No. 20-26: Extension of No Action Position Regarding Temporarily Working from Home Due to COVID-19</u>

Extends the Department's no-action position regarding licensure of certain branch office locations as a result of individuals who temporarily work from home during the COVID-19 outbreak

<u>Bulletin No. 20-25: Amendment to Minimum Standards for Health Benefits Plans to Facilitate the</u>
Availability of Bronze High Deductible Health Plans Effective for Plan Year 2021

Permits carriers in the individual and small employer markets only to use an individual network deductible of up to \$6,000 for Bronze HDHPs that could be used in conjunction with an HSA.

Bulletin No. 20-24: Response to COVID-19 (Supplement to Bulletin 20-03)

Expands the requirements in Bulletin 20-03 to require carriers to cover, without cost-sharing, without prior authorization or other medical management requirements, and SARS-COV-2 molecular test authorized pursuant to the DOH standing order

<u>Bulletin No. 20-23: Extension of Deadline for Certain Division of Banking Regulated Entities and</u> Individuals to File Annual Reports in Response to COVID-19

Provides guidance to certain entities that file reports with the Division of Banking

Bulletin No. 20-22: Premium Refunds, Credits, and Reductions in Response to COVID-19 Pandemic

Requires premium reductions for the private passenger automobile insurance line as well as for other lines of insurance

Directs Insurance Companies to Provide Premium Reductions to Drivers and Businesses Amid COVID-19

Bulletin No. 20-21 & Notice: Temporary Insurance Producer Licenses

Issues temporary producer licenses to qualifying individuals who wish to become New Jersey resident insurance producers

<u>Bulletin No. 20-20 & Notice: Extension of Insurance Producer License Terms and Waiver of Independent Monitor for Continuing Education Courses in Response to COVID-19</u>

Provides guidance to all licensed insurance producers, and insurance education schools regarding license terms and continuing education requirements

<u>Bulletin 20-19 - Use of Telemedicine and Telehealth During the COVID-19 Pandemic - Personal Injury</u> Protection Coverage

Provides guidance to all automobile insurers that provide medical expense benefits under Personal Injury Protection ("PIP") coverage (collectively, "PIP carriers") in this State regarding the use of telemedicine and telehealth, as defined in P.L. 2017, c.117, during the COVID-19 pandemic

<u>Bulletin 20-18 - Extension of Mortgage Servicer License Application and RMLA-Licensed Mortgage</u> Servicer Registration Deadlines

The Department is extending the deadline for license and registration applications under the Mortgage Servicers Licensing Act, N.J.S.A. 17:16F-27 to -46 (the "Act")

<u>Bulletin 20-17 - 90-Day Grace Period to Clients of Insurance Premium Finance Companies Due to the</u> Disruption Caused by COVID-19

Directs all insurance premium finance companies licensed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:16D-1 to -16 ("Insurance Premium Finance Company Act") to extend a grace period for the payment of premiums to their clients

Directs all life carriers to extend a grace period for the payment of premiums to their insureds

Directs all property and casualty insurance carriers to extend a grace period to their insureds

Provides required guidance to all to health carriers, dental service corporations, and dental plan organizations issuing small employer health and dental benefits plans in this State as well as brokers selling such plans regarding circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic

<u>Bulletin 20-11 - Guidance Concerning Circumstances Related to the COVID-19 Pandemic (Individual Market)</u>

Provides required guidance to health carriers, dental service corporations and dental benefits organizations to remove possible barriers to coverage and accommodate their covered lives given the circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic

Bulletin 20-09 - No Action Position Regarding Potential Disruptions Due to COVID-19

Issues guidance to all licensed New Jersey Real Estate Licensees, School Directors, Instructors, and Other Interested Parties

<u>Bulletin 20-08 - Temporary External Appeal Application Procedures for the Independent Health Care Appeals Program</u>

Issues guidance to all health insurance companies, medical service corporations, hospital service corporations, health maintenance organizations, organized delivery systems, and other entities that issue final adverse benefit determinations in this State (collectively "carriers"), as well as



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health care providers, covered persons, and other interested parties, regarding temporary procedures for the filing of External Appeal Applications for the Independent Health Care Appeals Program, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:2S-11, N.J.A.C. 11:24-8.7, and N.J.A.C. 11:24A-3.6

Bulletin 20-07 - Use of Telemedicine and Telehealth to Respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic

Issues guidance to all health insurance companies, health maintenance organizations, health service corporations and other entities issuing health benefits plans in this State (collectively "carriers") regarding the use of telemedicine and telehealth to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic

Bulletin 20-06 - No Action Position Regarding Temporarily Working from Home due to COVID-19

Issues guidance and informs mortgage lenders and certain regulated entities of no-action position regarding temporarily working from home due to COVID-19; Requires certain actions.

Bulletin 20-05 - COVID-19 Matters

Notifies regulated banking entities to provide prompt notice of changes to branch operating hours; inform regulated entities of requirement to submit notices, inquiries, correspondence, and applications electronically, effective immediately and until further notice

Bulletin 20-04 - Disruption Resulting from COVID-19

Encourages entities regulated by the department to work with and assist customers who have been adversely affected by COVID-19-related issues
